Where

Stalls

Stall sizes this year will be a minimum 2 metres deep and 2 metres wide. Cost of stalls is \$400.00 **per square metre**. Stalls are built to a height of 2.4 metres. Included in the stall cost are: one 1.2 m table, two chairs, standard lighting, power Board (with a maximum draw of 4 amp) and standard signage to a maximum of 30 characters

Presentations

Presentation Day is Tuesday 28th September. This is an opportunity for companies Tendering for TAG contracts to present in meeting style to the Members. Reservations for presentations fill quickly and are strictly limited in number. Presentation times are limited to 5 min preparation and 20 min presentations. Cost is \$600.00 for each 20min session.
